(b) The Secretary of State shall:

(1) index the executive orders that the Governor delivers under this section;

(2) keep each executive order during the term of office of the Governor who delivered the executive order, including a consecutive term; and

(3) then deliver the executive order to the State [Hall of Records Commission] ARCHIVES.

7-213.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section and § 3-405(b) of this article, 2 certified copies of each document to be published in the Code of Maryland Regulations or the Register shall be submitted to the Administrator, who:

(1) for 1 year after the publication of the document, shall keep and permit inspection of the copies; and

(2) then shall deliver the copies to the State [Hall of Records Commission] ARCHIVES.

SUBTITLE 10. STATE ARCHIVES AND ARTISTIC PROPERTY.

(a) In addition to any powers set forth elsewhere, the State Archivist may:

(1) adopt regulations to:

(i) govern the Archives;

(ii) manage the Hall of Records Building and other real and personal property that the Archives acquires;

(iii) manage the records under the supervision of the Archives; and
