- B. All of these inmates are serving their first adult incarceration;
- C. None of these inmates are serving a split sentence;
- D. None of these inmates have detainers or pending charges.
- E. All of the inmates will have served at least 50% of their total sentence by December 25, 1987;
- F. None of these inmates have been refused parole;
- G. None of these inmates have a record of significant disciplinary adjustment;
- H. Assurances have been received that each of the inmates listed in this Executive Order can be released without danger to the public safety; and
- WHEREAS, Having carefully considered the recommendations of the local authorities and the Maryland Parole Commission which have been made to me;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM DONALD SCHAEFER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, HAVING THOUGHT PROPER THE EXTENSION OF CLEMENCY, DO HEREBY, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY LAW, GRANT UNTO THE PERSONS LISTED IN THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER A COMMUTATION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THEIR SENTENCES AS IMPOSED FOR THE OFFENSES INDICATED:
