

Public Works shall count against the Rule of 50 imposed by the General Assembly. The establishment of new jobs or positions of employment not authorized in the F.Y. 1990 budget shall be subject to the State Finance and Procurement Article, Section 7-236 and the Rule of 50. Excess funds generated as a result of this ceiling shall be used to offset the need for the issuance of an amount of Consolidated Transportation Bonds during the fiscal year.
