(a) The Administration -{may-}- SHALL revoke the license of any [individual] PERSON who:

(1) Is convicted under § 21-902(a) or (d) of this article of driving or attempting to drive a motor vehicle while intoxicated or while under the influence of a controlled dangerous substance; or

(2) Within a -{3-year-}- 5-YEAR period, is convicted under § 21-902(b) or (c) of this article of three or more violations of driving or attempting to drive a motor vehicle
