(iii) A description of the licensee, which shall include the height, weight, and sex of the licensee;

(iv) The type or class of vehicles that the license authorizes the licensee to drive;

(v) The signature and seal of the issuing agent; and

(vi) A space for the signature of the licensee; and

(3) Shall include:

(i) If the licensee is under the age of 21 years, a profile photograph of the licensee; or

(ii) If the licensee is at least 21 years old, a frontal photograph of the licensee.

(d) (1) A license is not valid unless the licensee signs his name on it in his usual signature.

(2) When issued and signed, a driver's license authorizes the licensee to drive any vehicle of the type or class specified on it, subject to any restrictions endorsed on the license.

(e) (1) Only one current driver's license may be issued by the Administration to and held by any individual at any one time.

(2) Before issuing a license, the Administration [may] SHALL require the applicant to surrender any other license issued to him by any jurisdiction.

(a) (1) When an applicant applies for an initial driver's license or for a class of driver's license other than that which the applicant currently holds, the applicant shall pay the Administration a license fee of \$22. This fee covers issuance of a learner's INSTRUCTIONAL permit and, if the applicant qualifies before the learner's INSTRUCTIONAL permit expires, issuance of a driver's license.

(2) If a learner's INSTRUCTIONAL permit is not required, the applicant shall pay the Administration, when the driver's license is issued, a license fee of \$20.

(b) For the renewal of [any class of] A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A, B, C, D, E, OR M driver's license, a licensee shall pay the Administration a renewal fee of \$6.
