(III) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE.

13-203. CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION ABOUT APPLICANTS.

THE SUPERINTENDENT AND ALL MEMBERS OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE:

(1) SHALL TREAT AS CONFIDENTIAL ANY INFORMATION OBTAINED THROUGH AN INVESTIGATION OF AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE OR FOR CERTIFICATION UNDER THIS TITLE; AND

(2) UNLESS REQUIRED BY A COURT ORDER, MAY NOT DIVULGE TO A PERSON WHO IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE ANY INFORMATION OBTAINED THROUGH AN INVESTIGATION OF AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE OR FOR CERTIFICATION UNDER THIS TITLE.
