15-304. QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(B) CHARACTER AND REPUTATION.

THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD CHARACTER AND REPUTATION.

(C) EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE -- LAND SURVEYOR.

AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING SHALL MEET THE EDUCATIONAL AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 15-305 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(D) SAME -- PROPERTY LINE SURVEYOR.

(1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE PROPERTY LINE SURVEYING SHALL HAVE AT LEAST 6 YEARS OF WORK EXPERIENCE IN PROPERTY LINE SURVEYING THAT IS SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD AND THAT INDICATES TO THE BOARD THAT THE APPLICANT MAY BE COMPETENT TO PRACTICE PROPERTY LINE SURVEYING.

(2) IF AN APPLICANT HAS COMPLETED 1 OR MORE YEARS OF A CURRICULUM THAT INCLUDED THE STUDY OF THE PRINCIPLES AND METHODS OF SURVEYING AT A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, INCLUDING A COMMUNITY COLLEGE THAT THE BOARD APPROVES, IT MAY ALLOW, FOR EACH OF THOSE YEARS, BUT NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS, A 1-YEAR CREDIT TOWARDS THE EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(E) EXAMINATIONS.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, AN APPLICANT SHALL PASS EACH EXAMINATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is standard language added to introduce the basic requirements for an applicant for a license.

Subsection (b) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 335(f), except as that subsection related to a "land surveyor-in-training".

Subsections (c) and (e) of this section are new language added to provide convenient cross-references
