

(c) (1) In enforcing the provisions of law specified in subsection (b) OF THIS SECTION, the enforcement unit may:

(i) Conduct investigations and hold hearings;

(ii) Subpoena witnesses, examine persons under oath, and receive evidence; and

(iii) Compel the production of records, accounts, books, papers, and other documents.

(d) The enforcement unit shall cooperate with and assist the federal government, other states, and local government units, and the law enforcement personnel thereof, in enforcing the provisions specified in subsection (b) OF THIS SECTION.

(f) The powers granted by this section are in addition to any other powers granted to the Comptroller or his agent pursuant to the provisions specified in subsection (b) OF THIS SECTION.
