

(1) NO MORE THAN 350 ELIGIBLE PERSONS MAY BE ENROLLED IN THE ELIGIBLE PERSON REMEDIATION PROGRAM.

(2) THE INSTITUTION MAY PROVIDE OTHER REMEDIATION PROGRAMS THAT THE SECRETARY DESIGNATES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 31B, § 2(b) and (c).

In subsection (b) of this section, the reference to "[t]he Institution" is added to state expressly that which was only implied in the former law, *i.e.*, the Patuxent Institution is responsible for establishing and maintaining a research, development, and training effort.

Also in subsection (b) of this section, the reference to "programs" is substituted for the former reference to "program" for consistency with subsections (a) and (c)(2) of this section.

#### 4-203. DIRECTOR.

(A) CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER.

THE DIRECTOR IS THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF THE INSTITUTION.

(B) APPOINTMENT; QUALIFICATIONS; TERM; COMPENSATION.

(1) THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT THE DIRECTOR.

(2) THE DIRECTOR SHALL BE A TRAINED AND COMPETENT ADMINISTRATOR.

(3) THE DIRECTOR SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE SECRETARY.

(4) THE DIRECTOR IS ENTITLED TO THE COMPENSATION PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(C) MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION.

SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY, THE DIRECTOR SHALL MANAGE AND SUPERVISE THE INSTITUTION AND IMPLEMENT ITS PROGRAMS AND SERVICES.

(D) ANNUAL REPORT.

(1) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE DIRECTOR SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE SECRETARY AND THE GOVERNOR.

(2) THE ANNUAL REPORT SHALL STATE:
