(3) THE DIRECTOR AND EACH INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION ARE IN THE EXECUTIVE SERVICE, IN THE MANAGEMENT SERVICE, OR A SPECIAL APPOINTMENT IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.

- (A) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A BOARD OF REVIEW FOR THE INSTITUTION.

- (B) COMPOSITION.

THE BOARD OF REVIEW CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING NINE MEMBERS:

- (1) THE DIRECTOR;
- (2) THE TWO ASSOCIATE DIRECTORS;
- (3) THE WARDEN; AND

(4) FIVE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC, ONE OF WHOM IS A MEMBER OF A VICTIM'S RIGHTS ORGANIZATION, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
