

House Bill No. 664

AN ACT concerning

Kent County - Alcoholic Beverages - Sunday Opening Time

FOR the purpose of altering in Kent County the Sunday opening time for certain alcoholic beverages licensees; and generally relating to sales of alcoholic beverages in Kent County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

Section 11-515

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

11-515.

(a) This section applies only in Kent County.

(b) This section does not apply to any special or temporary license issued under § 7-101 of this article.

(c) Any class of retail on- or off-sale alcoholic beverages license issued by the Board of License Commissioners authorizes the holder to sell alcoholic beverages:

(1) On Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day;

(2) On Saturday from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day; and

(3) On Sunday:

(i) For a Class A license, from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day;

(ii) For a Class B license, from [12 noon] 9 A.M. to 12 midnight (off-sale for beer and wine only);

(iii) For a Class C license, from [11 a.m.] 9 A.M. to 12 midnight; or

(iv) For a Class D license, from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. (off-sale for beer and wine only).

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.
