Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 681 – Commission of Juvenile Justice Jurisdiction – Extension of Sunset.

This bill extends the termination date for the Commission on Juvenile Justice Jurisdiction from September 30, 2000 to September 30, 2001. The commission must submit a supplemental report updating the results of its investigation and study, together with any resulting policy recommendations, to the Governor and the General Assembly by September 30, 2001.

Senate Bill 614, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 11, 2000, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 681.

AN ACT concerning

Commission on Juvenile Justice Jurisdiction – Extension of Sunset

FOR the purpose of extending the termination dates that apply to the Commission on Juvenile Justice Jurisdiction; requiring the Commission to submit a certain report on or before a certain date; clarifying language; and generally relating to the Commission on Juvenile Justice Jurisdiction.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
