

Vehicle Law "[u]nder this subsection" for clarity.

In subsection (b)(3)(ii) of this section, as for the substitution of the phrase "carry out" for the former term to "implement", *see* General Revisor's Note to article.

Subsection (c) of this section is revised to clarify that the police officer acting under the authority of this section must notify the listed entities.

In subsection (c)(1)(i)1 of this section, the reference to a "municipal corporation" is substituted for the former reference to an "incorporated municipality" to conform to Md. Constitution, Art. XI-E.

In subsection (c)(1)(i)3 of this section, the exception for "Baltimore City" is added for clarity because Baltimore City is included in the standard definition of "county". However, Baltimore City is covered in subsection (c)(1)(i)2 of this section.

In subsection (c)(2) of this section, the reference to a police officer who "participates in a joint investigation with officials from another State, federal, or local law enforcement unit" is substituted for the former reference to a police officer who is "acting under the authority granted in paragraph (3)(i)1 of this subsection" for specificity and to eliminate an unnecessary cross-reference.

In the introductory language of subsection (d) of this section, the reference to a police officer who "acts" under the authority granted by this section is substituted for the former reference to a police officer who "uses" that authority for consistency with language used throughout this section.

As for authority granted to the State Police, *see* Art. 88B, § 4.

As for the substitution of the term "unit" for the former reference to "agency", *see* General Revisor's Note to article.

2-103. SAME — SERVICE OF ARREST WARRANTS.

(A) "PRIMARY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "PRIMARY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" MEANS:

(1) THE CHIEF OF POLICE, IF ANY, OR THE CHIEF'S DESIGNEE, IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION;

(2) THE CHIEF OF POLICE OR THE CHIEF'S DESIGNEE IN A COUNTY WITH A COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT;
