

MAY ENFORCE THE LAWS OF THE STATE TO THE SAME EXTENT AS AUTHORIZED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THE STATE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 602B.

Subsection (a) of this section is revised as a definition of "governing body" to provide a shorthand method to refer to the entities included in the term "governing body" for purposes of this section. It is based on the list in the first sentence of former Art. 27, § 602B(a) of enumerated entities that may authorize police and others to go or be sent beyond the territorial limits of the jurisdiction.

In subsections (b), (c)(1) and (2), and (g) of this section, the defined term "police officers" is substituted for the former references to "policemen" to use a gender-neutral term and for consistency with language used throughout this section. Similarly, in subsection (e)(1) of this section, the defined term "police officer" is substituted for the former reference to "police" to conform to the terminology used throughout this section.

In subsections (b) and (c)(2) and (3) of this section, the reference to "boundaries" is substituted for the former references to the "territorial limits" of a county or municipal corporation for brevity.

In subsection (b) of this section, the former phrase "as the case may be", which modified "county or municipal corporation", is deleted as surplusage.

In subsection (c)(1) of this section, the phrase "under the authority of subsection (b) of this section" is substituted for the former phrase "[i]n such event" for clarity and specificity.

Also in subsection (c)(1) of this section, the word "conclusively", which formerly modified "deemed", is deleted as surplusage.

2-106. KEEPING CUSTODY OF ARRESTED PERSONS.

(A) DISTRICT COURT COMMISSIONER IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION.

(1) A PEACE OFFICER, WHO IS APPOINTED IN THE JURISDICTION IN WHICH A PERSON IS ARRESTED, MAY KEEP CUSTODY OF THE ARRESTED PERSON IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION IN WHICH A DISTRICT COURT COMMISSIONER IS LOCATED TO BRING THE PERSON BEFORE THE DISTRICT COURT COMMISSIONER IN THE OTHER JURISDICTION.
