

(2) A REQUEST FOR NOTIFICATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL DESIGNATE:

(I) THE ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE VICTIM; OR

(II) THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF A VICTIM'S REPRESENTATIVE.

(3) A VICTIM OR VICTIM'S REPRESENTATIVE MAY, AT ANY TIME, WITHDRAW A REQUEST FOR NOTIFICATION.

(D) NOTIFICATION BY HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

IF A VICTIM OR VICTIM'S REPRESENTATIVE HAS REQUESTED NOTIFICATION IN THE MANNER PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE VICTIM OR THE VICTIM'S REPRESENTATIVE IN WRITING WHEN:

(1) THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT RECEIVES A COURT ORDER TO EXAMINE A DEFENDANT UNDER § 3-111 OF THIS TITLE;

(2) THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT RECEIVES A COURT ORDER COMMITTING A DEFENDANT TO THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT UNDER § 3-112 OF THIS TITLE;

(3) A HEARING IS SCHEDULED UNDER § 3-115 OF THIS TITLE;

(4) THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT RECEIVES NOTICE THAT A COMMITTED PERSON HAS APPLIED FOR A HEARING UNDER § 3-119 OF THIS TITLE;

(5) THE OFFICE RECOMMENDS THAT A COMMITTED PERSON BE RELEASED AFTER A HEARING UNDER § 3-115 OF THIS TITLE;

(6) THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT SUBMITS A RECOMMENDATION TO THE COURT FOR A COMMITTED PERSON'S CONDITIONAL RELEASE UNDER § 3-120 OF THIS TITLE;

(7) THE FACILITY OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT THAT HAS CHARGE OF A COMMITTED PERSON HAS NOTIFIED THE STATE'S ATTORNEY THAT A COMMITTED PERSON IS ABSENT WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION; OR

(8) THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT RECEIVES A COURT ORDER FOR THE CONDITIONAL RELEASE OR DISCHARGE FROM COMMITMENT OF A COMMITTED PERSON UNDER § 3-118, § 3-119, OR § 3-120 OF THIS TITLE.

(E) SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION AND REQUESTS.

ON NOTIFICATION BY THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A VICTIM OR VICTIM'S REPRESENTATIVE MAY SUBMIT, IN WRITING, TO THE STATE'S ATTORNEY AND TO THE FACILITY OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT THAT HAS CHARGE OF A COMMITTED PERSON:

(1) ANY INFORMATION THAT THE VICTIM OR VICTIM'S REPRESENTATIVE CONSIDERS RELEVANT; AND
