

(3) It shall be the responsibility of Allegany County to pay to each employee transferred under this section any compensation due to the employee on termination of County employment as of June 30, ~~2001~~ 2002.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 661

(House Bill 445)

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources – Tidal Fish License – Exemption for Live Bait Harvesters and Dealers

FOR the purpose of exempting certain persons engaged in certain commercial activity involving certain finfish from obtaining a certain license; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to conduct a certain study and provide a certain report by a certain date and in a certain manner; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to tidal fish licenses and an exemption for live bait harvesters and dealers.

Section 4-702

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2000 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

4-702.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b), a person may not buy, sell, ship, transport, or otherwise deal in finfish unless the person is licensed by the Department.

(b) The following persons are not required to obtain a license under this section:

(1) A person licensed by the Department to catch finfish for sale;

(2) A retail market, restaurant, or other establishment where finfish are sold or served to ultimate consumers, and not for resale;

(3) A person who buys finfish for personal use or consumption[.]; OR
