House Bill No. 331

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - County Treasurer - Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the County Treasurer of Cecil County; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent County Treasurer of Cecil County; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the County Treasurer of Cecil County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 25 - County Commissioners

Section 51(u)(1)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

51.

(u) (1) The salary of the County Treasurer of Cecil County is [\$48,000] \$60,000. The Treasurer may not receive any other income for performing the duties of his office.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the County Treasurer of Cecil County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the County Treasurer of Cecil County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
