

(11) Fail to comply with the provisions of Title 15, Subtitle 10A, 10B, or 10C or § 2-112.2 of the Insurance Article; [or]

(12) Violate any provision of § 19-712.5 of this subtitle; OR

(13) REQUIRE OR ATTEMPT TO REQUIRE A MEMBER OR SUBSCRIBER TO SELECT OR BE SEEN BY A NURSE PRACTITIONER UNDER § 19-705.1(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(b) If any health maintenance organization violates this section, the Commissioner may pursue any one or more of the courses of action described in § 19-730 of this subtitle.

Article - Health Occupations

8-306.

(A) An applicant qualifies for certification as a certified nurse practitioner only if the applicant passes a Board-approved examination.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL CREATE AND MAINTAIN AN INDIVIDUAL PROFILE ON EACH NURSE PRACTITIONER CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD THAT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(1) A DESCRIPTION OF ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION TAKEN BY THE BOARD AGAINST THE NURSE PRACTITIONER WITHIN THE MOST RECENT 10-YEAR PERIOD;

(2) A DESCRIPTION OF ANY FINAL DISCIPLINARY ACTION TAKEN BY A LICENSING BOARD IN ANY OTHER STATE OR JURISDICTION AGAINST THE NURSE PRACTITIONER WITHIN THE MOST RECENT 10-YEAR PERIOD;

(3) THE NAME OF ANY SCHOOL PROVIDING ADVANCED MEDICAL TRAINING THAT THE NURSE PRACTITIONER ATTENDED AND THE DATE ON WHICH THE NURSE PRACTITIONER GRADUATED FROM THE SCHOOL;

(4) A DESCRIPTION OF ANY SPECIALTY CERTIFICATION OF THE NURSE PRACTITIONER BY A RECOGNIZED NURSING BOARD;

(5) THE NAME OF ANY HOSPITAL WHERE THE NURSE PRACTITIONER HAS STAFF OR HOSPITAL PRIVILEGES;

(6) THE LOCATION OF THE NURSE PRACTITIONER'S PRIMARY PRACTICE SETTING; AND

(7) WHETHER THE NURSE PRACTITIONER PARTICIPATES IN THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

(C) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL PROVIDE APPROPRIATE AND ACCESSIBLE INTERNET LINKS FROM THE BOARD'S INTERNET SITE:

(1) TO THE EXTENT AVAILABLE, TO THE APPROPRIATE PORTION OF THE INTERNET SITE OF EACH HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION LICENSED IN THIS
