(2) Before a person acts as a reinsurance manager for a reinsurer domiciled in the State, the person must:

(ii) qualify as an [agent or broker] INSURANCE PRODUCER under Title 10, Subtitle 1 of this article.

(a) The Commissioner shall issue a license to each applicant that:

(2) pays the applicable fee for a [certificate of qualification] LICENSE for an [agent or broker] INSURANCE PRODUCER under § 2-112 of this article.

8-509.

(c) Before a license expires, the licensee may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:

(3) pays to the Commissioner the applicable renewal fee for an [agent or broker] INSURANCE PRODUCER under § 2-112 of this article.

8-511.

(a) Subject to the hearing provisions of §§ 2-210 through 2-214 of this article, the Commissioner may deny, refuse to renew, suspend, or revoke a reinsurance intermediary's license, or a reinsurance intermediary's [agent or broker's certificate of qualification] INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE, if the reinsurance intermediary has violated this subtitle or § 10-126 of this article.

(a) A reinsurance manager:

(3) may not appoint or hire an [agent] INSURANCE PRODUCER to solicit, procure, or negotiate reinsurance contracts for a reinsurer without ensuring that the agent is qualified under Title 10, Subtitle 1 of this article;

(b) If service is made in accordance with the Maryland Rules or other applicable law, a court with subject matter jurisdiction over an action brought under this subtitle also has jurisdiction over:

(1) a person, including an [agent, broker,] INSURANCE PRODUCER and another person that has written policies, that has acted in any manner on behalf of an insurer against which a delinquency proceeding has been commenced, in an action resulting from or incidental to the person's relationship with the insurer;

(2) a reinsurer that at any time has entered into a contract of reinsurance with an insurer against which a delinquency proceeding has been
