CHAPTER 83

(House Bill 527)

AN ACT concerning

Dredge Spoil - Cox Creek Citizens Oversight Committee

FOR the purpose of establishing a Cox Creek Citizens Oversight Committee to monitor the redeposit of dredge spoil and respond to citizen complaints in the Cox Creek area; requiring the Committee to appoint a liaison to the Innovative Use Advisory Council; providing for the appointment of members of the Committee; authorizing the Governor to establish the terms of members of the Committee; establishing the qualifications of members of the Committee; establishing the duties of the Committee; and generally relating to the Cox Creek Citizens Oversight Committee.
