Marshall, agent for Sarah Marshall the following property to wit: One yoke of oxen, one red yearling, one bay Mare colt, seven head of hogs, one ox Carte, one plow, one hoe, one iron pot, one oven and lid, one pair of andirons. as witness my hand and seal this 11th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty.
