

the Governor to remove members of the Board. For other provisions on removal, see Md. Constitution, Art. XV, § 2, on suspension and removal for crimes, and Art. 41, § 1-203 of the Code, on removal for failure to attend meetings.

In subsection (a) of this section, the former phrases "with the powers and duties hereinafter prescribed" are deleted as surplusage.

In subsections (b) and (d) of this section, the former references to selection "as the Governor may determine" and to vacancies being "filled by the Governor" are deleted as unnecessary in light of subsection (a) of this section.

In subsection (b) of this section, the former specific references to "employers" and "employees" are deleted as unnecessary to the extent that they were mere examples of "citizens of the State". The deletion of "employer" also avoids limiting the membership of employers to sole proprietorships. The Labor and Employment Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that, if it intended for the Board to be representative of employers and employees, this requirement should be stated as a limitation on the composition of the Board, rather than as a qualification of an individual appointee.

10-111. OFFICERS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE BOARD ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN, A VICE CHAIRMAN, AND A SECRETARY.

(B) ELECTIONS.

THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS SHALL BE AS THE BOARD DETERMINES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from the sixth sentence of former Art. 101, § 71(a)(1).

Subsection (b) of this section is standard language added to clarify the manner of election for officers of the Board.

In subsection (a) of this section, the phrase "[f]rom among its members" is added for clarity. This addition is based on practice.

(A) VOTING.

THE BOARD MAY NOT ACT ON ANY MATTER UNLESS AT LEAST 4 MEMBERS CONCUR.
