(2) the farmer has:

(i) at least 3 full-time employees; or

(ii) an annual payroll of at least \$15,000 for full-time employees.

(q) [(1)] An individual is a covered employee:

[(i)] (1) while on duty as a member of a volunteer company in Prince George's County that receives money as provided in § 650 of the Public Local Laws of Prince George's County;

[(ii)] (2) while on duty as a member of the Laurel Volunteer Rescue Squad in Prince George's County; or

[(iii)](3) if not covered under item [(i)] (1) or [(ii)] (2) of this [paragraph] SUBSECTION, while a member of a volunteer company in Prince George's County.

[(2)] The County Council of Prince George's County shall pay annually to each volunteer company in the county an amount equal to the cost to the company to secure compensation as required under paragraph (1) of this subsection.

(3) Each volunteer company shall use money received under this subsection to secure compensation as required under this subsection.]

(e) (2) On application and subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, the Commission shall return security that a governmental self-insurance group has deposited under this subsection if:

(i) the members of the governmental self-insurance group cease to be subject to this title or secure compensation through an authorized insurer or the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund; and

(ii) the governmental self-insurance group has not been liable on a claim for compensation during the 5 years immediately [preceding] AFTER the day on which the event described in item (i) of this paragraph [occurs] OCCURRED.

(b) (2) On application and subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, the Commission shall return security that an employer has deposited under this subsection if the employer:

(i) ceases to be subject to this title or secures compensation through an authorized insurer or the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund; and
