

THIS STATE. THE REGISTRATION SHALL INCLUDE THE TRADE NAME, TRADEMARK, QUANTITATIVE ANALYSIS, MANUFACTURER'S TRADE NAME, OR OTHER IDENTIFICATION OF THE ADDITIVE, AND THE SPECIFIC FORMULA AS TO THE AMOUNT TO BE BLENDED INTO SPECIAL FUEL. THESE ITEMS MAY ONLY BE INTRODUCED INTO SPECIAL FUELS FOR RESALE OR DISTRIBUTION BY A SPECIAL FUEL SELLER AND IN A MANNER SPECIFIED BY REGULATION.

[(b)] (C) It is unlawful to introduce into gasoline sold at retail any additive containing lead, after the gasoline has been received in this State.

(b) (1) Each retail service station dealer shall maintain a sign on the premises which states the lowest current price per whole measurement unit of [leaded] regular and [unleaded regular] MID-GRADE gasoline sold on the premises. The sign shall state the unit of measurement employed. Each sign shall be located so as to be readable by passing motorists.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 35

(Senate Bill 49)

AN ACT concerning

Abandoned Property – Agreements to Pay Compensation

FOR the purpose of providing that certain agreements to pay compensation to recover or assist in the recovery of certain property made within a certain time period are unenforceable; making a technical change; and generally relating to agreements regarding abandoned property.
