

IN ADDITION TO ANY REGULATION SPECIFICALLY REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE, REGULATIONS THAT THE COMMISSIONER ADOPTS TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE MAY INCLUDE:

(1) DEFINITIONS OF THE TERMS "ADMINISTRATIVE CAPACITY", "EXECUTIVE CAPACITY", "PROFESSIONAL CAPACITY", AND "OUTSIDE SALESMAN";

(2) A SCALE OF WAGES THAT IS SUITABLE FOR LEARNERS AND APPRENTICES BUT IS AT LEAST 80% OF THE MINIMUM WAGE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(3) A WAGE FOR A SPECIAL CASE OR CLASS OF CASE IF THE COMMISSIONER FINDS THE WAGE APPROPRIATE TO:

(I) AVOID UNDUE HARDSHIP;

(II) PREVENT THE CURTAILMENT OF EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY; AND

(III) SAFEGUARD THE MINIMUM WAGE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) INFORMATION FOR REGULATIONS.

ON REQUEST BY THE COMMITTEE, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE COMMITTEE INFORMATION THAT SHOWS CURRENT WAGES OR OTHERWISE IS RELEVANT TO ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) RECOMMENDATIONS BY COMMITTEE.

ONCE EVERY 2 YEARS, THE COMMITTEE:

(1) SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO REVIEW THE REGULATIONS CURRENTLY IN EFFECT TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) THEN AFTER THE HEARING, SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSIONER A WRITTEN REPORT THAT MAY INCLUDE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGES WITH REGARD TO RATES, COVERAGE, AND REGULATIONS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 100, § 86(a) and the sixth and seventh sentences of § 85(a).

The introductory language of subsection (a) of this section, "[i]n addition to any regulation specifically required by this subtitle", is substituted for the former specific reference to "allowances for board ... or services", to conform to § 3-418(c) of this subtitle.
