9-671. PROVIDER OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES — REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

(A) REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

A PERSON SHALL REGISTER WITH THE COMMISSION, AS CONSIDERED APPROPRIATE BY THE COMMISSION, BEFORE THE PERSON MAY PROVIDE VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES UNDER THIS TITLE IN THE STATE.

(B) REGISTRATION FORMS.

A PERSON WHO IS REQUIRED TO REGISTER UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL REGISTER ON THE FORM REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSION.

(C) FAILURE TO REGISTER — RECEIPT OF PAYMENT PROHIBITED.

A PERSON WHO FAILS TO REGISTER WITH THE COMMISSION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT RECEIVE PAYMENT FOR PROVIDING VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES.
