

(II) THE SCHOOL OFFERS AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM OR A VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM, THAT IS ACCREDITED OR APPROVED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

(J) CONTINUING JURISDICTION OF COMMISSION.

THE COMMISSION HAS CONTINUING JURISDICTION TO:

(1) DETERMINE WHETHER A SURVIVING SPOUSE OR CHILD HAS BECOME WHOLLY OR PARTLY SELF-SUPPORTING;

(2) SUSPEND OR TERMINATE PAYMENTS OF COMPENSATION;
AND

(3) REINSTATE PAYMENTS OF COMPENSATION THAT HAVE BEEN SUSPENDED OR TERMINATED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 101, § 36(7)(a), except for the introductory language of that subsection, (d), except as that subsection referred to a partly dependent child, the first sentence of (i), and the second clause of § 23(b).

In subsections (a), (c) through (e), (f)(2), and (g) through (i) of this section, the reference to the "employer or its insurer" is added to clarify that the employer or its insurer is responsible for paying compensation under this title and to conform to other provisions of this subtitle.

In subsection (a) of this section, the word "individuals" is substituted for the former word "persons", since only human beings are covered under this title.

In subsection (b)(1)(i) of this section, the former phrase "maximum of 100% of" is deleted as surplusage.

Also in subsection (b)(1)(i) of this section, the former phrases "as determined by the Department of Employment Security, as provided in subsection (2) of this section" are deleted as unnecessary in light of § 9-603 of this subtitle.

In subsection (b)(2) of this section, the reference to the "average" weekly wage is substituted for the former reference to the "established" weekly wage, to conform to terminology used throughout this title.

In subsections (d), (e), and (j)(1) of this section, the word "spouse" is substituted for the former words "wife" and "husband", for brevity.

In subsection (e) of this section, the former phrase "and thereafter further benefits shall cease" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the clause "the employer or its insurer shall continue to pay death benefits until \$45,000 has been paid".

In subsection (f) of this section, the term "surviving spouse" is substituted for the former terms "widow" and "widower", to conform to terminology used throughout this subtitle.
