

4-321. ACCEPTING MONEY OR GIFTS FOR FAVORS.

A MANAGER, SECOND, MATCHMAKER, PROMOTER, OR PRINCIPAL MAY NOT ACCEPT MONEY OR A GIFT FROM A BOXER, EXHIBITOR OF BOXING, KICK BOXER, OR WRESTLER IN RETURN FOR A SPECIAL PRIVILEGE OR FOR DISCRIMINATING IN MAKING A MATCH.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 123.

The former word "receiv[e]" is deleted in light of the word "accept".

The former reference to being "guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a penalty ..." is deleted as unnecessary in light of § 4-322 of this subtitle.

The Business Regulation Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that the meanings of the words "principal" and "exhibitor of boxing" are unclear. Similarly, the reference to "discriminating" in making a match is unclear.

The Committee also notes that this section is revised to apply to kick boxers as well as boxers and wrestlers.

4-322. CRIMINAL PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 125.

The former reference to a provision of this subtitle "for which a penalty is not expressly prescribed" is deleted as surplusage since specific penalties are placed with the specific prohibited acts to which they apply.

GENERAL REVISOR'S NOTE TO SUBTITLE:

Throughout this subtitle, the word "professional" is deleted as unnecessary from the former term "professional kick boxer". Because this subtitle does not apply to any amateur event, except as provided in § 4-302(b) of this subtitle, the word "professional" is implied in the use of the term "kick boxer". See § 4-302 of this subtitle.
