4-406. ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES; DISPOSITION OF MONEY.

(A) ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES.

THE SECRETARY SHALL SET REASONABLE FEES REQUIRED TO ADMINISTER THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) DISPOSITION OF MONEY.

THE SECRETARY SHALL PAY ALL MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 633(f)(1).

Subsection (b) of this section formerly was Art. 56, § 633(f)(2).

In subsection (a) of this section, the former word "necessary" is deleted as implicit in the word "reasonable".

4-407. LICENSE REQUIRED.

(A) IN GENERAL.

A PERSON MAY NOT ACT AS A SPORTS AGENT IN THE STATE UNLESS THE PERSON HAS A LICENSE.

(B) CONTACT WITH ATHLETE.

A SPORTS AGENT MAY NOT CONTACT, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, A LOCAL ATHLETE WHILE THE LOCAL ATHLETE IS IN THE STATE UNLESS THE SPORTS AGENT HAS A LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language added to state a fundamental prohibition implicit throughout the provisions of former Art. 56, §§ 632 through 640 that related to sports agent contracts and to conform to similar provisions governing other regulated occupations in the Code. This addition is supported by former Art. 56, § 633(a), now subsection (b) of this
