

TITLE 5. CEMETERIES.

SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS.

5-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language used as the standard introductory language to a definition section.

(B) BURIAL.

(1) "BURIAL" MEANS ALL FINAL DISPOSITION OF HUMAN REMAINS.

(2) "BURIAL" INCLUDES:

(I) EARTH BURIAL;

(II) MAUSOLEUM ENTOMBMENT; AND

(III) NICHE OR COLUMBARIUM INTERMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 23, § 165A(i)(3).

The Business Regulation Article Review Committee decided to substitute the word "burial" for the former word "interments" throughout this title.

(C) CEMETERY.

(1) "CEMETERY" MEANS LAND USED OR TO BE USED FOR BURIAL.

(2) "CEMETERY" INCLUDES A STRUCTURE USED OR TO BE USED FOR BURIAL.

SUBTITLE 2. CEMETERY CORPORATIONS.

5-201. LIMIT ON LAND HELD.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A CEMETERY CORPORATION MAY NOT BUY, HOLD, OR USE, FOR BURIAL:
