

(B) OBSTRUCTING PUBLIC ROAD OR FUTURE SITE PROHIBITED.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT AUTHORIZE A CEMETERY CORPORATION TO OBSTRUCT:

(1) A PUBLIC ROAD IN USE WHEN THE CEMETERY CORPORATION IS FORMED; OR

(2) THE SITE OF A FUTURE PUBLIC ROAD THAT, WHEN THE CEMETERY CORPORATION IS FORMED, IS SHOWN ON A PLAT MADE BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE, A COUNTY, OR A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first and second clauses of former Art. 23, § 163.

In subsections (a) and (b) of this section, the references to a "cemetery corporation" are substituted for the former references to a "cemetery company incorporated under ... this article" and "such corporation" for accuracy. The former provisions of Article 23 that governed corporations were transferred to the Corporations and Associations Article by Ch. 311, Acts of 1975.

In subsection (a) of this section, the former words "lanes" and "streets" are deleted as included in the general words "road" and "public thoroughfare". Similarly, in subsection (b)(1) of this section, the former words "street" and "lane" are deleted as included in the general word "road".

In subsection (b)(2) of this section, the reference to a "municipal corporation" is substituted for the former references to a "city" and "town" to conform to Md. Constitution Art. XI-E.

5-203. BURIAL LOTS AND CRYPTS.**(A) "CEMETERY" DEFINED.**

IN THIS SECTION, "CEMETERY" INCLUDES AN INCORPORATED, UNINCORPORATED, RELIGIOUS, OR SECULAR MEMORIAL PARK AND MEMORIAL GARDEN.

(B) LOT OR CRYPT FOR BURIAL PURPOSES ONLY.

EACH BURIAL LOT AND EACH CRYPT SOLD OR CONVEYED IN A CEMETERY SHALL BE HELD BY THE OWNER ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF BURIAL.

(C) HELD FOR BURIAL OF OWNER OR OTHERS.
