5-309. CEMETERY IN VIOLATION OF SUBTITLE.

(A) PROHIBITED ACT.

A PERSON MAY NOT ESTABLISH OR OPERATE A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE CEMETERY OR ALLOW A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE CEMETERY TO BE OPERATED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

(C) CORPORATE VIOLATIONS.

IF A CORPORATION VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE, EACH OFFICER WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE VIOLATION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

5-401. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.
