PART IV. GENERAL CRIMINAL PENALTY.

8-623. GENERAL CRIMINAL PENALTY.

(A) APPLICATION OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION ONLY APPLIES IF THERE IS NO GREATER CRIMINAL PENALTY PROVIDED UNDER THIS TITLE OR OTHER APPLICABLE LAW.

(B) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY VIOLATES THIS TITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR BOTH.

SUBTITLE 7. SHORT TITLE; TERMINATION OF TITLE.

8-701. SHORT TITLE.

THIS TITLE IS THE MARYLAND HOME IMPROVEMENT LAW.

8-702. TERMINATION OF TITLE.

SUBJECT TO THE EVALUATION AND REESTABLISHMENT PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND PROGRAM EVALUATION ACT, THIS TITLE AND ALL REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE SHALL TERMINATE ON JULY 1, 1992.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 269A.

The former phrase "creating the Maryland Home Improvement Commission and relating to the regulation of home improvement businesses" is deleted as surplusage. Similarly, the former phrase "may not be enforced after" is deleted as surplusage.
