#### 9-208. ORDER FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES.

AFTER A HEARING, THE COMMISSIONER MAY ORDER AN EMPLOYMENT AGENCY TO:

(1) REIMBURSE A CLIENT FOR ALL ORDINARY AND NECESSARY TRAVEL EXPENSES THAT THE CLIENT INCURRED AS A RESULT OF A REFERRAL BY THE EMPLOYMENT AGENCY IN VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE;

(2) REFUND ANY MONEY THAT THE EMPLOYMENT AGENCY TOOK FROM THE CLIENT IN VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE; OR

(3) DO BOTH.

#### 9-209. JUDICIAL REVIEW.

(A) IN GENERAL.

A PARTY TO A PROCEEDING BEFORE THE COMMISSIONER WHO IS AGGRIEVED BY A FINAL DECISION OF THE COMMISSIONER IN A CONTESTED CASE, AS DEFINED IN § 10-201 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, MAY TAKE AN APPEAL AS ALLOWED IN §§ 10-215 AND 10-216 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
