

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL MAIL TO THE LICENSEE AT THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE:

(1) A RENEWAL APPLICATION FORM; AND

(2) A NOTICE THAT STATES:

(I) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;

(II) THE DATE BY WHICH THE COMMISSIONER MUST RECEIVE THE RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES; AND

(III) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

(C) APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL.

BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE:

(1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;

(2) PAYS TO THE COMMISSIONER A RENEWAL FEE OF:

(I) \$200 FOR THE FIRST LOCATION WHERE THE LICENSEE DOES BUSINESS AS AN EMPLOYMENT AGENCY; AND

(II) \$100 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL LOCATION WHERE THE LICENSEE DOES BUSINESS AS AN EMPLOYMENT AGENCY; AND

(3) SUBMITS TO THE COMMISSIONER:

(I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE COMMISSIONER REQUIRES; AND

(II) A COPY OF EACH CONTRACT OR OTHER FORM THAT THE LICENSEE WILL USE AND HAS NOT ALREADY SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSIONER.

(D) ISSUANCE OF RENEWAL.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE OF EACH LICENSEE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
