9-320. NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF COUNSELOR.

AN EMPLOYMENT AGENCY SHALL NOTIFY THE COMMISSIONER WITHIN 5 DAYS AFTER TERMINATION OF THE EMPLOYMENT OF AN EMPLOYMENT COUNSELOR.

SUBTITLE 4. EMPLOYMENT COUNSELORS.

9-401. "LICENSE" DEFINED.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) INCLUDED LICENSES.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "LICENSE" INCLUDES:

- (1) A LICENSE TO ACT AS AN EMPLOYMENT COUNSELOR; AND
- (2) A TEMPORARY LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language added to avoid repetition of phrases such as "license to act as an employment counselor".

Subsection (b) of this section is new language added to provide a specific listing of the licenses covered under the defined term.

Occasionally, the term "licensee" is used in this subtitle as a synonym for a holder of any of the licenses included in this section.
