

(2) MAY INVESTIGATE THE INTEGRITY AND MORAL CHARACTER OF THE APPLICANT; AND

(3) UNLESS THE APPLICANT PREVIOUSLY HAD A LICENSE SUSPENDED OR REVOKED BY THE COMMISSIONER, SHALL ISSUE TO THE APPLICANT A TEMPORARY LICENSE.

9-405. APPROVAL OR DENIAL OF LICENSE.

WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE COMMISSIONER RECEIVES AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL:

(1) APPROVE OR DENY THE APPLICATION; AND

(2) GIVE THE APPLICANT IMMEDIATE NOTICE OF A DENIAL.

9-406. ISSUANCE AND CONTENTS OF LICENSE.

(A) ISSUANCE.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) CONTENTS.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH LICENSE THE NAME OF THE EMPLOYMENT AGENCY THAT WILL EMPLOY THE LICENSEE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is standard language added to express the formerly implied duty of the Commissioner to issue a license to a qualified applicant.

Subsection (b) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from the first clause of the fifth sentence of former Art. 56, § 163(b).
