

SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT.

10-201. ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(1) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THIS TITLE.

(2) THE COMPTROLLER MAY DELEGATE ANY POWER OR DUTY OF THE COMPTROLLER UNDER THIS TITLE.

(B) ENFORCEMENT POWERS.

TO ENFORCE THIS TITLE, THE COMPTROLLER MAY MAKE INVESTIGATIONS, HOLD HEARINGS, EXAMINE PERSONS UNDER OATH, AND RECEIVE EVIDENCE.

(C) SUBPOENAS.

TO ENFORCE THIS TITLE, THE COMPTROLLER MAY ISSUE SUBPOENAS FOR THE ATTENDANCE OF WITNESSES TO TESTIFY OR TO PRODUCE EVIDENCE.

(D) RIGHT OF ENTRY.

(1) FOR INSPECTION OR DRAWING SAMPLES, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL HAVE ACCESS, DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS, TO:

(I) EACH PLACE WHERE MOTOR FUEL IS STORED FOR SALE; OR

(II) EACH CONVEYANCE USED TO TRANSPORT MOTOR FUEL.

(2) A DENIAL OF ACCESS BY AN AGENT, OWNER, OR OTHER PERSON WHO OPERATES SUCH A PLACE OR CONVEYANCE IS PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF A VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a)(1), (b), (c), and (d) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 157C(a) and (b)(1) and the first sentence of § 157B(a).

Subsection (a)(2) of this section is new language added to conform to similar provisions elsewhere in this article. See §§ 16-102 and 17-202(c) of this article. See also §§ 3-202, 9-201, 14-105, and 14-205 of this article.

In subsections (a)(1), (b), (c), and (d)(2) of this section, the reference to "this title" is substituted for the former reference to "this subtitle" because the intent of the former law seemed to be for the Comptroller to administer and enforce the substantive provisions included in this "title", which were not limited to the former "subtitle".
