- (4) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD MAY NOT BE HELD PERSONALLY LIABLE FOR ANY ACTION TAKEN UNDER THIS SECTION.
 - (E) (1) THE BOARD OR ITS DESIGNEE MAY ISSUE A SUBPOENA.
- (2) THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE SHERIFF OF A COUNTY SHALL SERVE A SUBPOENA ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- (3) IF A PERSON FAILS TO COMPLY WITH A SUBPOENA ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, ON PETITION OF THE BOARD, A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION MAY COMPEL COMPLIANCE WITH THE SUBPOENA.

9A-207.

- (A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD MAY SET REASONABLE FEES, INCLUDING APPLICATION FEES, FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES AND ITS OTHER SERVICES.
- (B) REVENUES GENERATED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE AT LEAST EQUAL TO EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE BOARD.
- (C) THE BOARD SHALL PAY ALL MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

SUBTITLE 3. LICENSING

9A-301.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL PROVIDES OR ASSIST IN PROVIDING HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR-CONDITIONING, OR REFRIGERATION SERVICES IN THE STATE.

9A-302.

- (A) TO QUALIFY FOR A AN APPRENTICE, JOURNEYMAN, MASTER, MASTER RESTRICTED, OR LIMITED LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- (B) AN APPLICANT FOR A MASTER HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR-CONDITIONING, AND REFRIGERATION CONTRACTOR LICENSE SHALL:
- (1) HAVE BEEN REGULARLY AND PRINCIPALLY EMPLOYED IN PROVIDING HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR-CONDITIONING, OR REFRIGERATION SERVICES UNDER A JOURNEYMAN LICENSE FOR NOT LESS THAN 3 YEARS OF ACTIVE EXPERIENCE UNDER THE DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF A MASTER HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR-CONDITIONING, AND REFRIGERATION CONTRACTOR AND HAS BEEN SO EMPLOYED FOR NOT LESS THAN 1,875 HOURS IN THE YEAR PRIOR TO APPLICATION; AND
