- (c) From July 1, 1984, a member shall receive an allowance as provided in this subsection:
- (1) For retirement for service UNDER § 2-401(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE, the allowance is computed:
- (i) For creditable service before July 1, 1984, as provided by § 2-401(b) of this subtitle; and
- (ii) For creditable service from July 1, 1984, as provided for by § 4-401(b) of this article;
- (2) FOR RETIREMENT FOR SERVICE UNDER § 2-401.1(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE ALLOWANCE IS COMPUTED:
- (I) FOR CREDITABLE SERVICE BEFORE JULY 1, 1984, AS PROVIDED BY § 2–401(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (II) FOR CREDITABLE SERVICE FROM JULY 1, 1984, AS PROVIDED BY § 4-401.1(C) OF THIS ARTICLE;
  - (3) For early retirement for service, the allowance is computed:
- (i) For creditable service before July 1, 1984, as provided by § 2-402(b) of this subtitle; and
- (ii) For creditable service from July 1, 1984, as provided by § 4–402(b) of this article;
- [(3)](4) For retirement for ordinary disability, the initial allowance is computed on the greater of:
  - (i) The allowance as provided by § 2-404(a) of this subtitle; or
  - (ii) The allowance as provided by § 4-404(a) of this article; and
  - [(4)](5) For retirement for accidental disability, the allowance is computed:
- (i) For creditable service before July 1, 1984, as provided by § 2-404(b) of this subtitle; and
- (ii) For creditable service from July 1, 1984, as provided by § 4-404(b) of this article.

## 4-401.

- (a) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 4-401.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, A member may retire if:
- (1) The member has submitted a written application to the Board of Trustees stating the date on which the member desires to retire; and
