16-304. TERM OF LICENSE.

A COUNTY LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF ITS EFFECTIVE DATE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first clause of former Art. 56, § 631(f)(1).

Former Art. 56, § 631(f)(2), (3), and (4) and the second clause of (1), which provided for renewal of a county license, are deleted as unnecessary. As part of the revision of the Tax - General Article, renewal provisions were substituted for former Art. 56, §§ 63 and 64, which did not provide for a renewal scheme. The Business Regulation Article Review Committee determined that the renewal scheme was inappropriately added. When a county license expires, the licensee simply obtains a new license.

16-305. DISPLAY OF LICENSE.

A COUNTY LICENSEE SHALL DISPLAY THE COUNTY LICENSE IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE:

(1) IN THE PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR WHICH IT IS ISSUED; OR

(2) ON THE PREMISES WHERE THE MACHINE IS LOCATED, IF THE LICENSEE SELLS CIGARETTES THROUGH A VENDING MACHINE.

16-306. DENIALS, REPRIMANDS, SUSPENSIONS, AND REVOCATIONS — GROUNDS.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 16-307 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMPTROLLER MAY DENY A COUNTY LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT, REPRIMAND A COUNTY LICENSEE, OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE A COUNTY LICENSE IF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE:

(1) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE FOR THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE OR FOR ANOTHER PERSON;

(2) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY USES A LICENSE; OR
