

TITLE 17. MISCELLANEOUS STATE BUSINESS LICENSES.

SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS: GENERAL PROVISIONS.

17-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added as standard introductory language to a definition section.

(B) GOODS.

"GOODS" MEANS TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to provide an express definition of "goods" for this title.

(C) SALE.

"SALE" INCLUDES BARTER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to provide an express definition of "sale" for this title.

(D) SELL.

"SELL" INCLUDES BARTER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to provide an express definition of "sell" for this title.

(E) TRADER.

"TRADER" INCLUDES A PERSON WHO OPERATES A ROOM OR OTHER PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR SELLING GOODS AT AUCTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to provide an express definition of "trader" for this title. Since an auctioneer must get a trader's license, specific reference is added to what an auctioneer does. See Subtitle 18 of this title.

Defined terms: "Goods" § 17-101

"Person" § 1-101

(F) TRADER'S LICENSE.

"TRADER'S LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE CLERK TO DO BUSINESS AS A TRADER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid repetition of phrases such as "license issued by the clerk to do business as a trader".
