

(2) EXAMINE WITNESSES;

(3) RECEIVE EVIDENCE; AND

(4) ISSUE SUBPOENAS FOR THE ATTENDANCE OF WITNESSES
TO TESTIFY OR TO PRODUCE EVIDENCE.

(E) REGULATIONS.

THE COMPTROLLER MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO:

(1) CARRY OUT THIS TITLE; AND

(2) DEFINE ANY TERM USED IN THIS TITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a), (b)(1) and (2)(i), (d), and (e) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 11(a), (c), (d)(1), (2), and (3), the first, second, and fourth clauses of (b), and the second and third clauses of (e).

Subsection (b)(2)(ii) is standard language added to reflect that under SF § 10-203, the Board of Public Works has adopted regulations for reimbursement of expenses.

Subsection (c) of this section is new language added to conform to other titles in this article. See §§ 16-102 of this article. See also §§ 3-202, 9-201, 14-105, and 14-205 of this article.

In subsection (a) of this section, the reference to "this title" is substituted for the former reference to "the license laws of this State", which was overly broad. The Comptroller supervises the issuance of licenses by the clerks, not all the license laws of the State.

In subsection (b)(1)(ii) of this section, the former reference to "three or more" license inspectors is deleted as obsolete.

In subsections (d) and (e) of this section, the reference to this "title" is substituted for the former reference to this "article" because the Comptroller did not have authority to adopt regulations for and enforce all of former Article 56.

In subsection (d)(4) of this section, the reference to producing "evidence" is substituted for the former reference to producing "books", "accounts", "records", "papers", and "correspondence" for brevity and to conform to other provisions of this article.

Also in subsection (d)(4) of this section, the former power of the Comptroller to "sign" subpoenas is deleted as included in the general power to issue subpoenas.
