(C) PINBALL MACHINE LICENSE.

"PINBALL MACHINE LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE CLERK TO KEEP A FREE-PLAY PINBALL MACHINE FOR PUBLIC USE.

17-406. SCOPE OF PART.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY AND BALTIMORE, CAROLINE, DORCHESTER, HARFORD, KENT, MONTGOMERY, QUEEN ANNE'S, AND TALBOT COUNTIES.

(B) MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO FREE-PLAY CONSOLE MACHINES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 18(5) and the first sentence of § 19(5).

The Business Regulation Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that in accordance with subsection (a) of this section, Part II of this subtitle applies in Baltimore City. However, under § 17-407 of this subtitle, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore may license free-play pinball machines and free-play console machines in accordance with Chapter 27 of the Acts of 1951. The General Assembly may wish to reconcile these provisions.

17-407. AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY.

THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE MAY LICENSE FREE-PLAY PINBALL MACHINES AND FREE-PLAY CONSOLE MACHINES UNDER CHAPTER 27 OF THE ACTS OF 1951 AND THE ORDINANCES IMPLEMENTING THAT CHAPTER.
