(Senate Bill 487)

AN ACT concerning

County Income Tax

FOR the purpose of altering the increments by which a county may increase or decrease the county income tax rate; ~~authorizing a county to elect to be excluded from certain modifications to the State income tax for purposes of determining the county income tax;~~ authorizing a county to decrease its county income tax rate ~~or make a certain election~~ for a certain taxable year notwithstanding certain notice requirements; providing for the application of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the county income tax.
