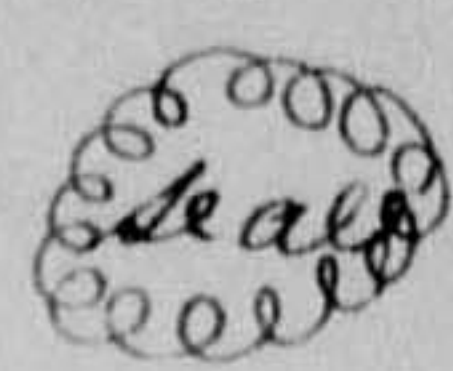

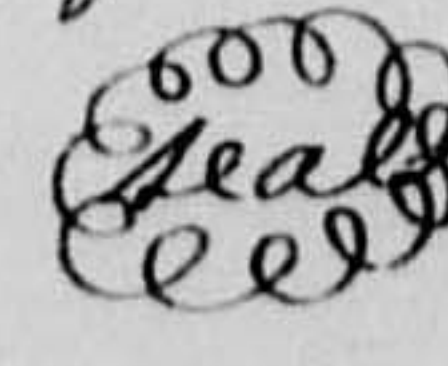

This Indenture made this 15th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between Samuel Deale of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland of the one part and Samuel Deale Jr (Seaman) on the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Deale for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Deale Jr. hath bargained and sold unto the said Samuel Deale Jr one negro^{by} the name of Sam and hath delivered the said negro by unto the said Samuel Deale Jr. To have and To hold the said negro boy Sam to him the said Samuel Deale Jr. his heirs and assigns forever; and I the said Samuel Deale do hereby agree by these presents to warrant and forever defend unto him the said Samuel Deale Jr. his heirs and assigns forever.

State of Maryland, Anne Arundel County, to wit: On this 15th day of March 1831 personally appears Samuel Deale before the subscriber a Justice of the peace in and for the County aforesaid and acknowledges the within Bill of sale to be his act and deed for the purposes therein mentioned and the negro boy therein mentioned to be the property of and to be in the possession of him the said Samuel Deale Jr. acknowledged before I J. Wilson.

Know all men by these presents that I John Hawkins of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars current money of the State of Maryland in hand paid by Richard Green of the County and State aforesaid at or before the enrolling and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge myself content therewith have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents grant, bargain and sell unto the said Richard Green his executors, administrators and assigns my three negro slaves now in the employ of Ellicott & Brothers
