

named Simon aged fifteen years, one ditto named Nathan aged fourteen years, one ditto named David aged eight years, one negro hire named Harriet aged fifteen years, one ditto named Mary Ann age eight years and one small boy named John aged four months & one negro woman named Charity aged about twenty four years to serve until the year Eighteen hundred and thirty seven all of which said slaves are now in my possession. To have and To hold the said described negroes above bargained and sold to the said James Owings his executors, administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit, and I the said Henry H Owings for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said James Owings his executors, administrators and assigns, the said described negroes against me, my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this eighth day of June Eighteen hundred and thirty.

A County and State of Maryland for and in the consideration of the sum of thirty dollars current money to me in hand paid by John Cole of the County and State aforesaid at or before the enacting and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Allen Warfield do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said John Cole his executors, administrators and assigns Eleven head of Hogs, 1 Colt one year old, one third part of all the crop of Coon made on the farm of the said Allen Warfield now planted, one third of the oats made on said farm by James Anderson and all the apples now growing in the orchard of the said farm all of which property now in my possession To have and To hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said John Cole his executors and administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said Allen Warfield for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said John Cole his executors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my executors
