the twenty ninth day of July in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirteen and that
the said woman named Fanny was raised in the
County aforesaid

Given the 6th Oct: 1818

Maryland Anne Arundel County, town: I hereby
certify to all whom it shall rightly concern that I
shall have proved to my satisfaction that the bearer
hereof a negro woman named Lely aged about thirty
years about five feet three and a half inches
high black complexion a remarkable scar upon
the breast and several scars upon the right arm
is the identical person mentioned by Mary Israel
by deed dated the sixth day of September eighteen
hundred and thirteen, and that the said negro
woman named Lely was raised in the County aforesaid
