in the County aforesaid

Maryland Anne Arundel County town: I hereby
certify to all whom it shall concern that it
has been proved to my satisfaction that the bearer
hereof a negro woman named Lacey (or Susanna Campbell)
aged about thirty five years about five feet two and
three quarters inches high, black complexion and
black gums, is the identical person mentioned
by Magistrate Hopkins before as noted the trial being
of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and eleven; and that the said
negro woman named Lacey (or Susanna Campbell)
was raised in the County aforesaid
