myself my heirs Executors and Administrators release
unto the said Dinah all my right and Claims which
ever as to her person or any Estate she may acquire
hereby declaring the said Dinah absolutely free
without any interruption from me or any person
claiming under me In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this twelfth day of March
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred &
Ninety nine
